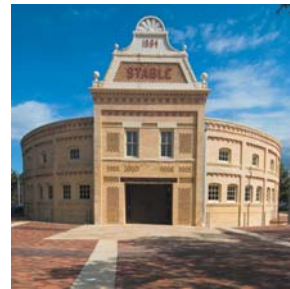

Tour of Mission Reach Project/ Visit to Historic Mission San Jose

Time: 1:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Tour Guide: Matthew Driffill, San Antonio River Authority. Those signed up should meet in the Westin Lobby at 12:45 p.m. Bus transportation provided.

The historic San Antonio River has long served as the heart of the city. Each year the world-renowned River Walk draws millions of visitors, yet miles of urban river with untapped potential lie beyond downtown. The Mission Reach Ecosystem Restoration and Recreation Project is transforming an eight-mile stretch of the San Antonio River into a quality woodland ecosystem. This unique project reintroduces native plants, enhances aquatic habitat, adds multiple recreation opportunities and reconnects cultural and historical features. This tour will also include a visit to the Mission San José, founded in 1720. A visitor in 1777 referred to the structure as the "Queen of the Missions." The church's carvings are among its most notable features and the famous "Rose Window" is considered one of the finest pieces of Spanish Colonial ornamentation in the country.

Toyota Plant Tour and Economic Development Discussion

The tour covers fun facts plus information about the San Antonio River, Spanish Missions, San Fernando Cathedral, Market Square, city projects, past and present, SA2020, Historic District Development and more. You'll cover roughly 5 miles of downtown San Antonio on your Segway and see sites such as Alamo Plaza, Hemisfair Park, Alamodome, La Villita Historic Art Village, and more. Guide provides training before the start of the tour. Guests are asked to arrive 10-15 mins prior to tour start in order to maximize tour time. Each tour lasts 90 minutes.

Guided Bike Tour

Limited to 15 people per tour. Meet at Segway Nation (260 East Houston Street) 15 minutes prior to the tour time. Cost to participate is \$20. Walking maps available in the hotel lobby.

Another great way to see San Antonio is by bike. Your guide will take you to sites such as the Main Street Plaza and San Fernando Cathedral, the Mission Reach Project, Mission Concepcion, Mission San Jose, The Blue Star Arts Complex and Brewery, King William District, Alamo Plaza and more. Arrive 10-15 mins prior to tour start in order to get your bike, helmet, lock and chain, water, etc. Tour lasts approximately 90 minutes.

Blue Star Contemporary Arts Center

One of San Antonio's best-known mixed-use development is the Blue Star Arts Complex, an innovative adaptation of historic warehouse buildings turned into an arts-oriented development of affordable loft/studio apartments, galleries, retail, performance spaces, artists' work spaces, and design offices. At the center of the complex is the Blue Star Contemporary Art Center, the first and longest-running venue for contemporary art in San Antonio. Now in its 25th year, Blue Star continues to be an incubator for contemporary art in San Antonio. Blue Star has grown with the community, instigating positive change in both the art community and the community at large as it has been a catalyst of re-development in this south San Antonio neighborhood.

Cafécollege Resource Center

Visit Cafécollege resource center, a facility located in a former city training center in downtown San Antonio. Cafécollege offers an accessible and centrally-located center, which provides a robust array of support services to achieve the goal of more San Antonians attaining college degrees. The target audience is middle through high school youth, adult learners choosing to pursue higher education for the first time, and first generation college attendees. Cafécollege helps students decide on a career, apply to college, identify and apply for financial aid.

Programs include Career Exploration, College Admission Assistance, Financial Aid Guidance, SAT & ACT Preparation and much more. During this visit, you will also meet with San Antonio education leaders to learn of education initiatives in San Antonio. You will meet Andria Castillo, VP of Education and Workforce Development for the Greater San Antonio Chamber of Commerce; Eyra A. Perez, Executive Director of the San Antonio Education Partnership, the organization that oversees Cafécollege, Mari Aguirre, Executive Director of GenTX; and Jeanne Russell, Education Policy Advisor to San Antonio Mayor Julián Castro.
