






Nonfarm Payroll Employment






USA Nonfarm Payroll Employment Monthly Growth in Thousands

Total Non-Farm Employment Percentage Change Feb 2020 to October 2023







Nonfarm Employment Change by Sector February 2020 – October 2023








Bluegrass Region Job Growth 2017-2022






Competitor Metro Employment Growth 2017-2022






Percentage Employment Growth Competitor Regions – Sept 2022 to Sept 2023




Change in U.S. real GDP

Real GDP (Index: Q4 2019 = 100)






GDP Per Capita Three Year % Growth 2019 - 2022






Percentage GDP Growth Competitor Regions 2016 to 2021






3 Year Growth in Per Capita GDP vs Per Capita Personal Income


COL Adj Wage Private Sector Jobs 2022






Percentage Average Hourly Wage Growth Competitor Regions 2017 to 2022




Consumer Spending and Income






Personal Saving Rate





Manufacturing Job Announcements per Year, Reshoring + FDI, 2010 thru 2022









Change in Personal Consumption Expenditures Price Index














Population 10 Year Annual Growth Rate






Percentage Population Change 2020-2022






Projected Population Change 2023–2033 Ages 25-64











9-County Region Population 2006-2023




Bluegrass Region Labor Force Growth 2017-2022








Housing Price Increase 2020Q1 to 2023Q2






Median Household Income as % of Median Home Price







MSA Housing Value Competitor Regions - October 2023







State and Local Tax Collections Per Capita, Fiscal Year 2021









■ Vacancy rates (%) ■ New supply (millions of square feet; msf)











Fiscal years; 1962–2023











The average child care payment is up 32% from 2019, according to new data from the Bank of America Institute.

The price surge outpaced overall inflation; the Consumer Price Index was up 20% over the same period.








