

## IMPORTANT TRIP NEWS & NOTES:

### CHECK-IN AT BLUE GRASS AIRPORT ON JUNE 15:

Check-In begins at 6:30 a.m. and the flight departs at 8:00 a.m. Upon arrival, please proceed to the Allegiant Air Ticket Counter, where Commerce Lexington employees will assist you. There are no seat assignments, so feel free to sit where you like. You will receive luggage tags at the airport. 
### WEATHER:
