Through a partnership formed between Commerce Lexington Inc. and the University of Kentucky's Gatton College of Business & Economics, a scholarship in the amount of \$10,000 will be available to a Commerce Lexington Inc. member to help defray the cost of the program beginning in August 2019. The goal is to provide an opportunity for an advancing leader in the regional business community to demonstrate their desire to improve the economic environment of Central Kentucky, while furthering their own personal development.

The University of Kentucky and the University of Louisville Executive MBA is unique in that it focuses on how to best operate a business using real world techniques and cutting-edge specialties, including business intelligence, mergers and acquisitions, and social media.

The program runs over the course of 20 months, meeting every other weekend on Friday/Saturday, with terms scheduled in both Lexington and Louisville. This scholarship is \$10,000 and will be distributed through 4 equal installments.
